INTER-COUNTY TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIP RULES AND ORGANISATION

Notes:

1. From 2004, there will be a revised *common format* for Men's and Women's Championships.
2. The Championship arrangements are administered by the NoEAA T&FC in consultation with the County District Associations who meet annually to discuss the fixture.

NoEAA Inter County Championships

1. Date and venue: Normally held on the first/second weekend in August at a 'reasonably central' venue. All events will now be held on ONE day.

2. Programme of events

In all events, each competing County, or group of Counties, may select one competitor, irrespective of standard.

Men

Senior Men: 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 3000m, 110mH, 400mH, 3000mSC, 5km Walk, Medley Relay
HJ, PV, LJ, TJ, SP,DT, HT, JT

U17 Men: 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 3000m, 100mH, 400mH, 1500mSC, 3km Walk, Medley Relay
HJ, PV, LJ, TJ, SP,DT, HT, JT

U15 Boys: 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 80mH, 2.5km Walk, Medley Relay
HJ, LJ, SP, DT, JT

Women

Senior Women: 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 3000m, 100mH, 400mH, 5km Walk, Medley Relay
HJ, PV, LJ, TJ, SP,DT, HT, JT

U17 Women: 100m, 200m, 300m, 800m, 1500m, 3000m, 80mH, 300mH, 3km Walk, Medley Relay. HJ, PV, LJ, TJ, SP,DT, HT, JT

U15 Girls: 100m, 200m, 800m, 1500m, 75mH, 2.5km Walk, 4x100m
HJ, LJ, SP, DT, JT

3. Rules:

- * There are no entry standards. However, the minimum take-off board for Senior TJ is 11m (men) and 9m (women).
- * U15 and U17 athletes may only compete within their own UKA age-group.
- * All athletes must have an individual county qualification (UKA rule 9) and *not* have represented or competed in the championships of another English county in that calendar year.
- * Where events are run in lanes and there are more than 8 competitors, two heats will be run. Overall placings will be decided on times.

* In Field Events, all competitors will have 4 trials (Excluding Pole Vault & High Jump)

4. Scoring: 8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1 points for 1st, 2nd,...8th in each event

5. Trophies: Perpetual trophies for U15, U17, Senior and aggregate performance; plus additional 'handicap' trophies.

Named trophies are as follows:

Senior Women:	Phyllis Pope Trophy
U17 Women:	Bertha Crowther Trophy
U15 Girls:	Lincoln Trophy
Aggregate:	Margaret Oakley Trophy
Women's handicap*:	Phyllis & Percy Pope Trophy
Men's handicap*:	Ken Oakley Trophy

*The '*handicap*' score is obtained by dividing the *aggregate* score by the county population in millions
